Vineyard Notes

The 2020 vintage in Margaret River was one of the best the region had seen in many years. With lower rainfall and higher than average temperatures it allowed for a perfect growing season. No early bird pressure and a bit of precision crop management gave the fruit optimal opportunity to achieve flavour ripeness. Having the great growing season can easily be seen in the fruit profiles that these wines display.

Production Notes

The fruit from both varieties were hand harvested at optimal flavour ripeness and then processed the same day they entered the winery. Keeping a cool and controlled ferment allowed for the wines to reach dryness. However we held back a portion of pure grape juice for blending to create a sweet yet refreshing palate.
