A WORD OF WINE ADVICE

What's so special about oak? The use of oak in winemaking has a long and cherished history. Here's why we still choose to age our red wines in oak barrels.

There are many good reasons why oak has traditionally been used to age and store wine, and why the ancient craft of cooperage (barrel-making) remains revered. It wasn't until the 1600s that glass bottles were available; until then, wine was aged, stored and sold in oak barrels.

Nowadays the fermentation is often carried out in both stainless steel tanks and oak barrels. This is because oak's flavour compounds – think vanilla, clove spice and charred wood – add their own layers of complexity to a wine's taste, texture and aroma.

Oak's porous structure helps to introduce oxygen incrementally into the wine, resulting in a smoother, more rounded finish to the wine. This structure varies from species to species, and is why winemakers may prefer French oak over American oak, or vice versa, depending on the desired wine style or type of grape.

French, or European, oak has a tight, dense grain, meaning less oxygen is integrated, leading to a subtle flavour profile and tighter tannins. This makes it suitable for more elegant styles. American oak, with its more open grain, allows in more oxygen, therefore imparting more of the oak's characteristics and producing 'bigger', textured wines.

At Brown Hill, all our red wines from all our ranges go into oak barrels, including our Prospector's Range. We use barrique and hogshead barrels (225 litres and 300 litres respectively) that are brand new or up to four years old. The younger the oak, the more flavour it imparts, so it's not just grapes that are blended in winemaking; the oak can be too.

For example, our Signature wines go into a minimum of 50% new oak; our Reserves, 35% and Prospector's, 25%. Even the French oak styles have variations that bring specific characteristics. So, for our cabernets, we use Bordeaux oak; and our shiraz, Burgundy oak. Among the coopers who supply our barrels are Taransaud, St Martin, Louis Latour, Nadalie, Seguin Moreau and François Frères.

Going the extra mile: proudly announcing the release of our new Golden Mile Signature Shiraz, 25 years in the making.

Hand-picked and hand-sorted from the best parcels of shiraz grapes on our single-site vineyard, the Golden Mile Signature Shiraz is the latest addition to the Brown Hill portfolio of superb red wines.

Given that 2020 will mark Brown Hill's 25th anniversary, we wanted to make a Signature Shiraz utilising everything we've learned over a quarter of a century of grape growing. In effect, the Golden Mile Signature Shiraz has been 25 years in the making.

While Margaret River is known predominantly as a cabernet region, the Brown Hill site is particularly good for shiraz, and our winemaker Nathan Bailey has been working on this latest release for some years, trialling a combination of different oak barrels. The Burgundy oak barrels he finally chose are a combination of Louis Latour, Seguin Moreau and François Frères, which together bring a range of complex flavours and textures to the wine.

Made from Brown Hill's best fruit and aged in 100% brand new oak for 18 months, then in the bottle for 12 months so far, this very special, straight shiraz style will benefit from up to 15 years' cellaring.

This wine is named after the Golden Mile in Kalgoorlie/Boulder, which was once considered the richest square mile on earth, having produced 60 million ounces of gold and counting — the name is a reflection of the sheer quality of our shiraz, as well as our family's heritage. Just 95 cases will be available, and our Wine Club customers will be first in line, so make sure to enquire when you visit us here in Margaret River, or check in online to avoid the 'gold rush'!

2019 Charlotte Sauvignon Blanc

The nose bursts with passionfruit aromas and dances with a beautiful perfume of tropical fruit. The palate is deliciously crisp, with pink grapefruit undertones and a flinty mineral backbone. A great wine to serve with oysters and seafood.


