Vineyard Notes

The 2019 vintage in Margaret River was milder than average. High bird pressure and humidity were mitigated through careful crop management and the early application of bird netting. The cooler season lengthened the ripening of grapes, giving us picking windows for optimal grape development. This favoured the intensity of flavour and aroma profiles of the finished wines,

Production Notes

The fruit was selected from the best block of Cabernet Sauvignon on our single site vineyard. Hand harvested and processed over our sorting table into a mixture of stainless steel and open top fermenters and left on skins for 21 days to create a depth of colour and flavour. Once the ferment was complete the wine was transferred into premium Bordeaux barriques for 18 months maturation. Post maturation the best barrels were selected, blended and bottled in November 2020

Truffle butter basted porterhouse with hasselback garlic potatoes and seasonal greens
