Vineyard Notes

The Golden Mile Range is selected from a small portion of our vineyard to showcase what our small patch of land can do. In 2019 we experienced a milder than average summer, with high bird pressure and humidity. We mitigated this through careful crop and canopy management and the early application of bird netting. The growing season that we experienced allowed for ripening to occur at a much slower rate than other years, giving us the opportunity to pick at the optimal grape development favouring the fruit intensity of flavour and aroma that this great variety can express.

Production Notes

The fruit for our Golden Mile range is selected from small blocks on our single site vineyard. Hand harvested and processed over out sorting table to ensure only the best quality fruit is transferred in stainless-steel fermentation vessel and left on skins for up to 21 days to create depth and texture in this unique style of Margaret River Shiraz. Once pressed off the wine is transferred to a mixture of French oak barriques for 18 months maturation. Out of these batches only the two best barrels are selected, blended, filtered and bottled in November the following year.
