## 2019 Hannans Cabernet Sauvignon

### Tasting Notes

Colour: Deep, dark red  
Nose: Blackcurrant and dark cherry with savoury oak.  
Palate: Plum, cassis and black olive compliment mineral complexity.  
Cellar: 10 years

### Vineyard Notes

The 2019 vintage in Margaret River was milder than an average summer. High bird pressure and humidity were mitigated through careful crop management and the early application of bird netting. The cooler season allowed slow ripening of grapes and longer picking windows for optimal grape development favouring intensity of flavour and aroma.

### Production Notes

The fruit was hand harvested at a variety of ripeness levels to create complexity within the fruit flavour profile of the wine. Once in the winery the fruit was hand sorted and processed into fermentation vessels which was held around 25 degrees Celsius and took approximately 10 days to complete. After being pressed off it was packed down into French oak barrels of which 18% were new. The wine was matured in oak for 12 months before bottling creating a delicate and approachable style of Margaret River cabernet
