## 2019 Lakeview Sauvignon Blanc Semillon

### Tasting Notes

Colour: Quartz white with golden tones.  
Nose: Gooseberry, lime and passionfruit.  
Palate: Lemon curd, passionfruit and white nectarine with a long citrusy finish.  
Cellar: 4 years

### Vineyard Notes

The 2019 vintage in Margaret River was milder than an average summer. High bird pressure and humidity were mitigated through careful crop management and the early application of bird netting. The cooler season allowed slow ripening of grapes and longer picking windows for optimal grape development favouring intensity of flavour and aroma.

### Production Notes

The grapes were handpicked at a variety of ripeness levels. After being chilled to 5 degrees Celsius overnight the fruit was destemmed and pressed the following day. The Sauvignon Blanc portion of this wine was fermented in French oak barrels in order to create complexity and softness in the finished wine.

### Food Pairing Notes

Seared scallops with a white wine vinaigrette.
