Vineyard Notes

The 2020 vintage in Margaret River was one of the best the region had seen in many years. With lower rainfall and higher than average temperatures it allowed for a perfect growing season. No early bird pressure and a bit of precision crop management gave the fruit optimal opportunity to achieve flavour ripeness. Having the great growing season can easily be seen in the fruit profiles that these wines display.

Production Notes

The grapes were handpicked and processed in the winery the same day. Small portions of both Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon were whole bunch pressed and put down to French oak barriques to allow wild fermentation to occur. These portions were kept separate until blending occurred when they were brought together for the perfect marriage.
