Vineyard Notes

A cool wet spring paired with great soil health set the tone for a great start to the warm summer. As the weather started to turn leaf plucking and fruit dropping were instigated, putting us in strong position for the warm wet conditions to come. Further canopy and fruit management allowed us to pick with optimum ripeness and great fruit intensity.

Production Notes

The parcels of fruit were handpicked, processed and fermented separately to allow each variety to showcase the best of itself. A small portion of each was wild fermented in barrel to allow a complexity of aroma profiles to be created. Once barrel maturation had been completed each parcel was brought together for the final blend, resulting in a beautiful display of white fleshy fruits and great acidity.
