Tasting Notes

Colour: Deep purple

Nose: Violet, allspice and liquorice.

Palate: Raspberry, mulberry, black berries, and savoury oak contrast to create length and complexity

Cellar: 10+ years

Vineyard Notes

The 2019 vintage in Margaret River was milder than average. High bird pressure and humidity were mitigated through careful crop management and the early application of bird netting. The cooler season lengthened the ripening of grapes, giving us picking windows for optimal grape development. This favoured the intensity of flavour and aroma profiles of the finished wines

Production Notes

The small Malbec block was hand harvested and processed over our sorting table. After being pressed off the wine was put down to a mixture of French oak barriques to allow for maturation. The 2019 Oroya was created with an intense fruit profile and dense palate, which showcases what this variety can do when it stands alone.
