Palate:	Muddled red and dark fruits of plum and blueberry supported by secondary notes of sweet spices, cinnamon and dark chocolate. Elegant silky tannins provide a long lasting finish.

Vineyard Notes

A cool wet spring paired with great soil health set the tone for a great start to the warm summer. As the weather started to turn, leaf plucking and fruit dropping were instigated, putting us in a strong position for the warm wet conditions to come. Further canopy and fruit management allowed us to pick with optimum ripeness and great fruit intensity

Production Notes

The fruit was hand harvested from various blocks of Cabernet Sauvignon on our single site vineyard. The fruit was processed over the sorting table and transferred to fermentation tanks where it was left on skins for 18 days. After fermentation the wine was pressed and transferred to a selection of French Bordeaux barriques and matured for 18 months. Post maturation the wine was blended, filtered and bottled in November 2022

Ribeye steak with portobello mushroom sauce and seasonal vegetables.
